Belwin Conservancy is looking for one to two ephemeral artists, or groups of artists, to create ephemeral art in collaboration with the public at Belwin's Annual Bison Festival on May 18<sup>th</sup>, 2024. All materials used will be taken from Belwin's surrounding prairie. **Artist Call due Monday, March 11, 2024**.

To construct and deconstruct ephemeral art on site.

To learn about materials found on the prairie, how they function, and why they are important to the survival of all species.
